The basic requirements for admission to the German School New Delhi are a good command over the German language and availability of seats in the respective group/class. In case sufficient seats are not available in the individual groups/classes then a waiting list will be drawn up for admission.

Application formalities

- **Passport copy of the child** (page with photograph)
- Passport copy of parents/legal guardian/s and person/s vested with the child's care and custody (page with photograph)
- In case of students, one copy of the last half-yearly report or end of year report card

Interactive session

On completion of the above formalities, we will hold an interactive session with you at a previously agreed upon date. In order to enable you to get to know the School better and for us to get to know you better, we will fill up a questionnaire together with you during the course of our discussions and after taking inputs from you.

Needless to say, all the information furnished by you will be kept confidential. If you wish, a representative of the school's parents' council would be glad to guide you through the process as well.

The DSND is a recognised overseas German school which imparts education to its pupils in keeping with the aims and objectives of the German education system and leading up to German school leaving qualifications.
