Stationery and other materials for Class 1

The German School New Delhi purchases all the school books in Germany and gives them out to the pupils in the first school days. The invoice will be sent to the parents.

Notebooks and plastic folders can be purchased at the school office. All stationery and school materials, except those in bold, are available in India. Well-stocked stationery shops can be found at Khan Market and in South Extension.

3 notebooks A5 size, "Lineatur 1" (lined for the first grade), **on a pastel coloured background; notebook covers: 1x red, 1x yellow**

1 math notebook A5 size "Lineatur 7" (large grid); **notebook cover: 1x blue**

7 plastic folders, in the following colours: red, blue, green, yellow, purple, white, black

1 Display book with 20 pockets (available in stationery stores in India)

Please label all notebooks and folders from the outside with the child's name.

1 drawing pad A4 size

1 drawing pad A3 size

1 wide binder (folder) with a pack of dividers

1 A4 folder with envelope flap for loose worksheets

1 A3 folder / envelope (for the child's artwork)

1 Display book with 20 pockets (available in stationery stores in India)

1 pencil case with the following content:

1 eraser

2 pencils

Wooden colour pencils (good quality)

1 small ruler (15cm)

1 Folienstift (very fine non-permanent marker), water soluble, black, fine

1 zipped pencil case with one large pocket for extra supplies with the following content:

1 pair of scissors (Attention: left handed!)

1 large glue stick (please colourless and good quality, for example **Pritt!**)

1 sharpener

Felt Tip Pens (good quality)

Plasticine in a box/tin (if new, please unpack and pre-knead!) Please do not send Play-doh, it tends to dry out too fast)

Wax crayons (good quality)

1 box of good quality paints (water colours) with an additional tube of white paint ("**Deckweiß**")

3 brushes of different thickness

3 bristle brushes of different thickness

1 cup, 1 cloth, 1 apron for painting

1 placemat (at least A3) made of plastic as base for crafting and painting

2 clothes pegs/pins with your child's name written on them

Gym bag with the following content:

Sports pants

Sports shirt

Sneakers (no Velcro please)

Swimming clothes (in summer)

Goggles

1 drinking bottle

The children can certainly continue to use all existing materials which are still usable. Please label all the materials/stationery!

Please also consider buying extra notebooks.
